SUMMARY OF MINUTES CALHOUN COUNTY COMMISSION NOVEMBER 14, 2018

County Administrator Mark Tyner welcomed guests to the Commissioners' inauguration for the term beginning November 14, 2018, and ending November 15, 2022. Dr. C. O. Grinstead, Pastor, Trinity Baptist Church in Oxford, gave an invocation. The Honorable Alice K. Martin, Probate Judge for Calhoun County, administered the oaths of office to Commissioner Fred Wilson, Commissioner Tim Hodges, Commissioner J. D. Hess, and Commissioner Lee Patterson. The Honorable Kim McCarson, Circuit Clerk for Calhoun County, administered the oath of office to her father, Commissioner Eli Henderson.

Following comments by each Commissioner, Commissioner Wilson called the regular meeting of the Calhoun County Commission to order.

The Commissioners approved the payment of warrants issued, to-wit:

A motion was made by Commissioner Hess and seconded by Commissioner Patterson to adopt the agenda. All Commissioners voted in favor of the motion.
